ACCC Approves Ampol's Acquisition Of EG Australia

June 3, 2026 — Cumberland Farms welcomes today's announcement by the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission ("ACCC") approving Ampol's acquisition of EG Australia. The ACCC's approval is conditional on Ampol giving an undertaking to divest 41 sites, for which Ampol has entered into a binding sale agreement with Metro Petroleum.

Both parties have also agreed to cash-settle the scrip component of the purchase price on completion. The cash amount of the scrip settlement is A\$315 million. Net proceeds will be used to repay Group debt.

The divestment of EG Australia is expected to complete on 30 June 2026. A further update will be provided on completion.
